### **Rome :**

### **Venice :**

This hotel is located in the town center, 5 minutes' walk from St. Mark's Square, the Palazzo Grassi and public transport links. The location of the hotel is particularly privileged - a home in the heart of the city; a unique chance to experience real Venetian life in a pleasant and relaxed atmosphere. This historical city hotel, built in 1894 and renovated in 2007, offers 68 rooms. Popular with performing artists and painters for decades, it displays autographed photographs in the lobby. The tranquility and 19th-century Venetian atmosphere of the hotel is also enjoyed by an international blend of leisure travelers. The bright entry hall forms a triangle shape, which connects the original building on the left to the new wing on the right. All guestrooms are unique, each with its own charm, all in Venetian style.

### **Milan :**

1. **Ibis Hotel Centro 3sup stars :** (<http://www.ibis.com/it/hotel-0933-ibis-milano-centro/index.shtml>)

Ibis Milano Centro is a modern 3-star property offering comfortable accommodation near the heart of Milan. Highlights include onsite dining and an excellent location for shopping. The area surrounding the traditional Porta Venezia city gate is prestigious and home to the city's main shopping street, Corso Buenos Aires. Nearby places of interest include the historic Piazza della Repubblica and the public park Giardini Pubblici Indro Montanelli, which contains the 18th-century Villa Reale, a former residence of Napoleon and now home to the Galleria d'Arte Moderna. Repubblica metro station is located in the vicinity, providing fast and easy access to other popular Milan destinations.

## ITINERARY

### **1<sup>st</sup> Day 22 July : Rome**

Arrival in Rome and private transfer to the hotel. Rest of the day at leisure. Overnight

### **2<sup>nd</sup> Day 23 July: Rome**

Buffet breakfast and overnights at the hotel. Free time at leisure or possibility to book optional visits.

### **3<sup>rd</sup> Day 24 July: Rome / Venice**

Buffet breakfast in the hotel. In the afternoon transfer to the central station and departure by high-speed train (*Freccia Rossa*) to Venice. Arrival in Venice and private transfer by water Taxi to closest point to the hotel (we will need to walk 5 minutes). Day at leisure or possibility to book private visits of the city overnight

### **4<sup>th</sup> Day 25 July: Venice**

Buffet breakfast and overnights at the hotel. Free time at leisure or possibility to book optional visits

### **5<sup>th</sup> Day 26 July : Venice / Milan**

Buffet breakfast in the hotel. In the morning transfer to the central station and departure by Euro Star train (*freccia Bianca*) to Venice. Arrival in and private transfer by bus to the hotel. Day at leisure or possibility to book private visits of the city overnight

### **6<sup>th</sup> Day 27 July: Milan**

Buffet breakfast and overnights at the hotel. Free time at leisure & shopping or possibility to book optional visits.

### **7<sup>th</sup> Day 28 July: Milan**

Buffet breakfast and overnights at the hotel. Free time at leisure & shopping or possibility to book optional visits.

### **8<sup>th</sup> Day, 29 July: Milan/Airport**

Buffet breakfast in the hotel. Transfer to the airport on time for you flight. End of our services
